Millcreek Township Trustees Regular Meeting Minutes March 5, 2012

The Millcreek Township Trustees of Union County, Ohio convened in regular session from 7:00 p.m. to 8:50 p.m. at the Millcreek Township Community Building for the monthly meeting. Mr. Lynch called the meeting to order with the following members present:

Sheriff's Report

Deputy Haycox had nothing to report.

Economic Development District

Eric Phillips addressed the trustees about the potential to expand enterprise zone 178C located in Paris and Union Townships.

- Advantages for the community include becoming more competitive in attracting new industry, increase local tax revenues and employment opportunities, existing property remains fully taxable, and the only uses are for office and manufacturing.
- Businesses benefit from offsetting the high cost of business start-up, reinvesting in current operations to remain competitive and for growth, and provides Union County sites a competitive advantage.
- Mr. Phillips identified areas on the Millcreek Township zoning map that he feels would benefit from being included in an enterprise zone. The land is contiguous to enterprise zone 178C.
- Mr. Conroy stated he would like to resume negotiations with the City of Marysville on a JEDD agreement. Mr. Jordan noted that most of the area identified for an enterprise zone by Mr. Phillips on the Millcreek Township map correspond to the land use growth map adopted by Millcreek Township. Mr. Lynch would like more time to consider establishing enterprise zones within the township.
- The trustees decided to hold a special meeting on March 19 at 7:00 p.m. to discuss the creation of an enterprise zone for portions of Millcreek Township.

Zoning

Zoning Administrator

Mr. Clase presented the monthly call and activity log for February.

Zoning Commission

The Zoning Commission did not hold a meeting in February due to lack of a quorum.

Trustees

Mr. Lynch

- The neighborhood watch and PSO meeting was well attended. There are seven potential watch captains.
- Mr. Lynch submitted a draft of a land use map for Millcreek Township from the Upper Society Planning Commission. The map has been amended to reflect more agricultural land within the township.
- **Resolution #1093:** motion to accept the draft of the land use map for Millcreek Township from the Upper Society Planning Commission by Mr. Jordan, seconded by Mr. Conroy.
- Motion unanimously approved.

Mr. Conroy

- Mr. Conroy is still working with Solarity to provide high speed internet for the township.
- A request was received, from a resident, for a group to spend the night in the township building. The trustees agreed this would pose a liability issue for the township and this is not a viable option for the township building.

Mr. Jordan

- The building front door continues to leak even after replacing the weather stripping. It was suggested a door company be contacted to adjust the doors to alleviate the gap between the doors.
- **Resolution #1094:** motion to appoint Mr. Jordan as the representative to the Union County Health Department by Mr. Lynch, seconded by Mr. Conroy.

Other

The trustees thoroughly reviewed the bank statement/bank reconciliation and confirmed the bank statement and cancelled checks had not been modified in any way. The trustees duly noted the check sequence from the previous month ending with check #3365 and checks presented for approval at the current meeting beginning with check #3366. The trustees compared the accuracy of the expenditures/electronic fund withdrawals and receipts to those listed in the minutes.

- **Resolution #1095:** motion to approve the bank statement and bank reconciliation by Mr. Lynch, seconded by Mr.Jordan.
- Motion unanimously approved.

The trustees attested to the payment of the bills. The fiscal officer certified funds are available for the payment of the bills which were presented and approved by the trustees.
